

Those people must be going to Emmaus.




## Scriptures (SKRIP-churz)

# How to Find a Bible Verse

Let's look up your memory verse. Second Peter 3:18 tells where to find the verse.

What does 2 Peter mean?

2 Peter is called a book of the Bible. The Bible is one big book made up of lots of little books.

The first number of the Bible reference tells the chapter.

2 Peter 3 tells me that I need to find chapter 3, right?

Right! We turn the pages until we find a big number 3. That's chapter 3.

The last number in your Bible reference tells the verse number.

2 Peter 3:18 has an 18 at the end, so I want verse 18.

Here it is! 2 Peter chapter 3, verse 18.


